- Review clinical case notes and identify outreach needs
- Quality Improvement Projects (e.g. referral process, follow-up surveys, etc.).
- Generate various programmatic reports and analyze outcome data
- Review and application of state and agency policies and practices related to MH day services (e.g. admission criteria for Psychosocial Rehabilitation and Peer Support programs
